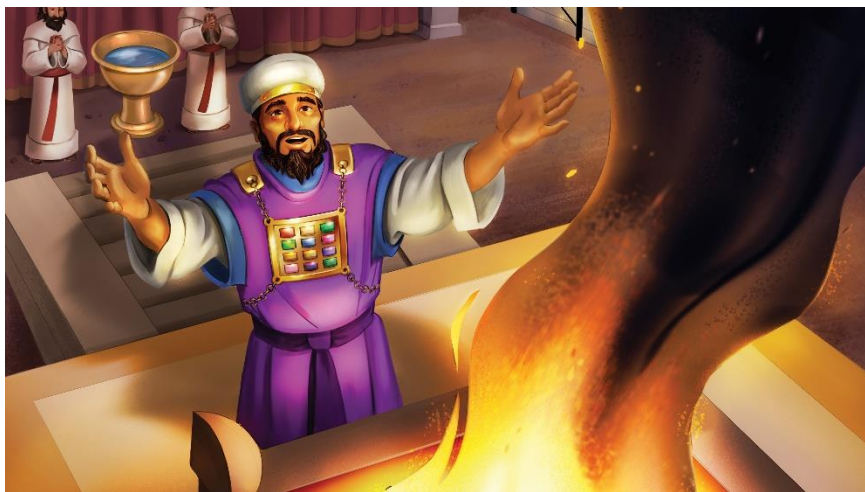

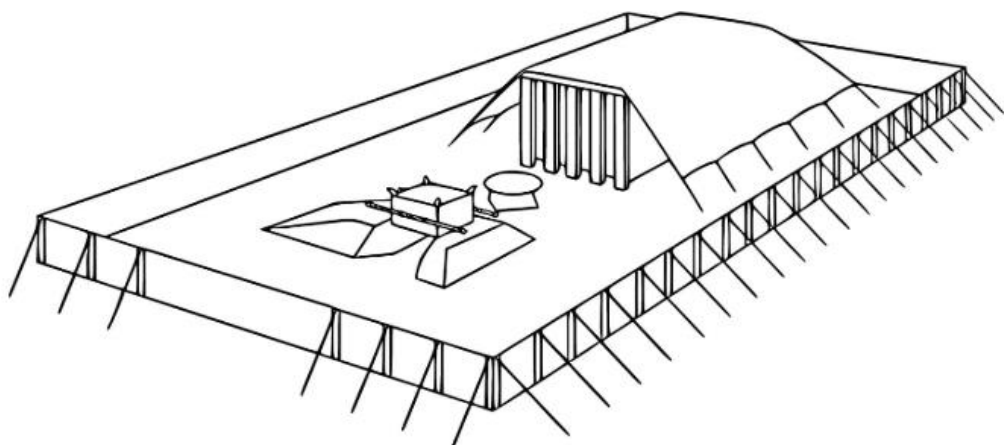

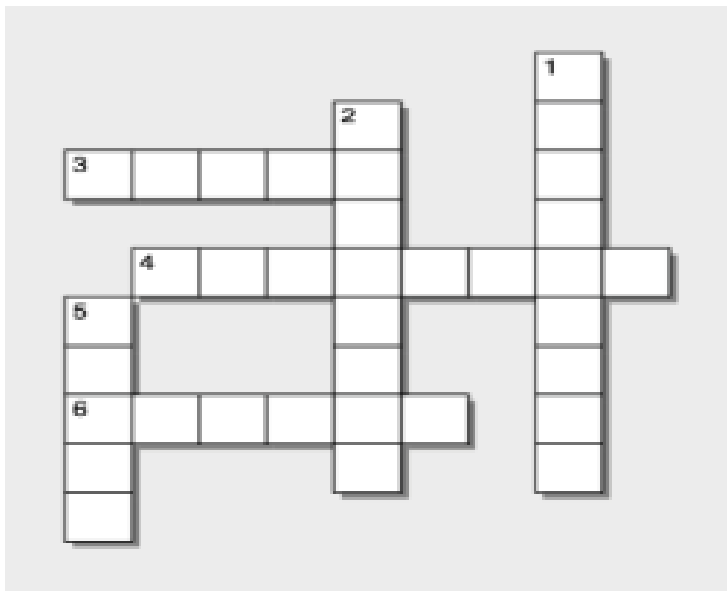
JESUS GIVES.

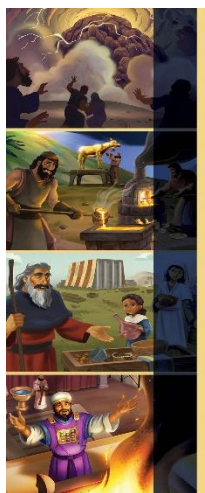
